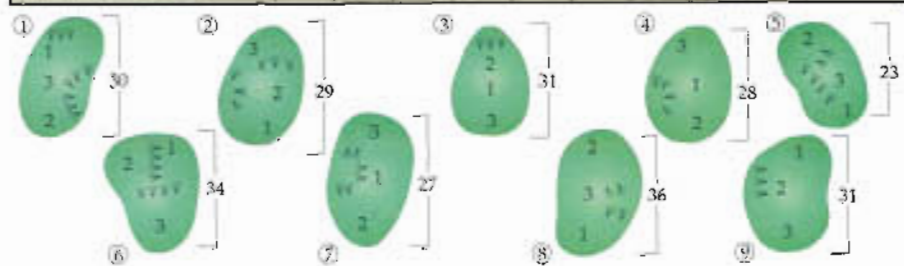

USGA RULES WILL GOVERN ALL PLAY ALONG WITH THE FOLLOWING RULES.

- Out of Bounds is defined by:
 - The inside edge of white stakes or lines, villa walls, & wooden fences.
 - In the absence of stakes, the inside edge of street curbs, paved public roads or transportation trails.
- Water Hazards are defined by Yellow Stakes or Lines.
- Lateral Water Hazards are defined by Red Stakes or Lines.
- Environmentally Sensitive Areas are marked as water or lateral water hazards & are identified by grass-strepped stakes. Golfers are not allowed to enter these areas for any reason including playing or retrieving their golf ball, & must proceed with the options available under rule 26-1. In addition, you may not stand inside the margins of environmental area to play a ball lying outside the area. You must take free & complete relief from the environmental area in this instance as outlined in appendix 1 Part B.
- 150-Yard Posts are movable obstructions.
- The Embedded Ball Rule is in effect "through the green".
- Ground Under Repair which allows free relief under the following conditions:
 - Areas enclosed by white lines.
 - Any unusual damage caused by maintenance vehicles, golf carts or the like.
 - Any newly sodded areas relief is permitted for the lie of the ball only.
 - Flower and / or shrub beds (does not include cord grass beds and/or naturalized areas)- **RELIEF IS MANDATORY**
 - Staked Trees and/or built up tree wells.
- In the event of an odd course handicap, the extra stroke is applied to the first rine played.
- Devices used for measuring yardages, such as the sky cadike, are permitted to be used during normal play or any Village sponsored tournament.
- The scoring area is deemed to be the entire club house grounds.
- Scorecard playoffs for all Village sponsored events will be broken by the USGA Rules of Golf, Appendix 1.

Etiquette

- Expected pace of play is 4 hours & 20 minutes.
- Please observe The Villages' dress code.
- Maximum of two people per cart and each player must have their own clubs.
- Please repair ball marks on the greens, rake bunkers, and fill divots in the fairways with sand provided to you.
