Helpful Tips

Expected pace of play is 90 minutes per round. To ensure an enjoyable experience for everyone, please observe the following recommendations.

1. Arrive at the course at least 20 minutes in advance of your assigned starting time.
2. Check in with the starter to pay your entry fee.
3. Each team must designate a scorekeeper who is responsible for recording and having the score attested by another team member at completion of the round.
4. Attested scorecards must be returned within 15 minutes after completion of play with two signatures required. Scores are posted within one hour after last flight has been completed.

About Men's and Ladies' Days

The format of play for Men's and Ladies' Days is a select-shot golf scramble, with teams randomly paired each week.

Pairings and starting times for the following week may be viewed on Fridays at GolfTheVillages.com and at the starter building of the requested course. Prizes are awarded in the form of golf shop credit redeemable at any of The Villages Championship Golf Shops. The number of prizes will be determined by the number of teams, and may vary from week to week.

The Importance of Your Reservation

If you have to cancel prior to the day of play, please contact the appropriate starter building so a substitute may be recruited.

All reservations are on a week-to-week basis and are taken on a first come first served basis. Reservations not canceled or notified within 10 minutes of the start will be considered a no-show and filled with a substitute.

Rules of Play

Select-Shot Scramble

- Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf and local rules pertaining to each specific course. Play is for 9 holes.
- Each player tees from the designated markers. Men age 80 and older may move one tee box forward during Men's Day.
- The best shot is selected and each team member then hits from this position. If the selected shot is in the fairway, each ball may be placed within one club length of that spot, no closer to the hole. The first player may improve the lie of their ball and play may be in any order.
- When selecting to play a ball that lies in the rough, each player may place their ball within one club length of where the chosen ball lies, no closer to the hole, and must remain in the rough. Play may be in any order.
- When choosing a ball that lies in a bunker, each player may place their ball within one club length of where the chosen ball lies, no closer to the hole, and must remain in the bunker.
- When beginning to putt, the selected ball must be marked and each player putts from the marked spot. Any ball holed out ends the hole. (*Don't tap in by mistake before all players have hit.*)
- Practice putting while waiting is a violation of the Rules of Golf and is not permitted.
- Ties will be broken per U.S.G.A. Rules of Golf Appendix I.
